

Access to Mindstretch with one account

As of the new release of the Mindstretch app, you only need one account for both your Fitbit app and your Mindstretch app.

For existing users, in order to be able to continue monitoring, it is important to carry out one action first. It's not very difficult. This guide explains what you need to do in three steps.

- Download the latest version of Mindstretch from the App Store or Google Play Store, if this has not already been done automatically.
- Log back into the Mindstretch app by pressing the Fitbit/Google button.


If you still have a Fitbit account, enter your Fitbit login details here. If you already have a Google account, choose 'Continue with Google'.

Note: select the Fitbit or Google account you have used before to connect Mindstretch with the Fitbit app and the Fitbit tracker.



Give Fitbit permission to allow Mindstretch to use your profile to log into Mindstretch from now on.




